In 2006, she was *Bad Ambassador* to Melbourne International Comedy Festival (MICF), Adelaide Cabaret Festival (*SOLD OUT*) and Edinburgh Fringe ("Lovechild of Mick Ronson and Kiki Dee" The Herald). Her wild season at Adelaide Fringe finished in March ("The best reason to go to the Fringe this year" Sunday Mail). Now, she charges in fresh from MICF, where she's slayed them with her monster-rock-cabaret SEXDEATHBOWIE.

The writer of cock-rock wish-list *Penis Envy* and nerd manifesto *Doctor Who's Assistant* has realised she's seen as the most bleak, inappropriate songwriter around. So, Quinn's plumbed the depths of her blackened soul and her remarkable musical range to arm herself with a songbook-arsenal inspired by three noble, recurring themes: SEX. DEATH. DAVID BOWIE.

A repeat sell-out in Australia, Quinn (www.geraldinequinn.com) has recently won Australia's Green Room Award for Best Emerging Cabaret Artiste and was nominated for Original Songs alongside Tim Minchin. She earns 4-plus star reviews in Australia & UK and was in the David Letterman showcase in Edinburgh 2006. This is a formidable performer – catch her while you can.
